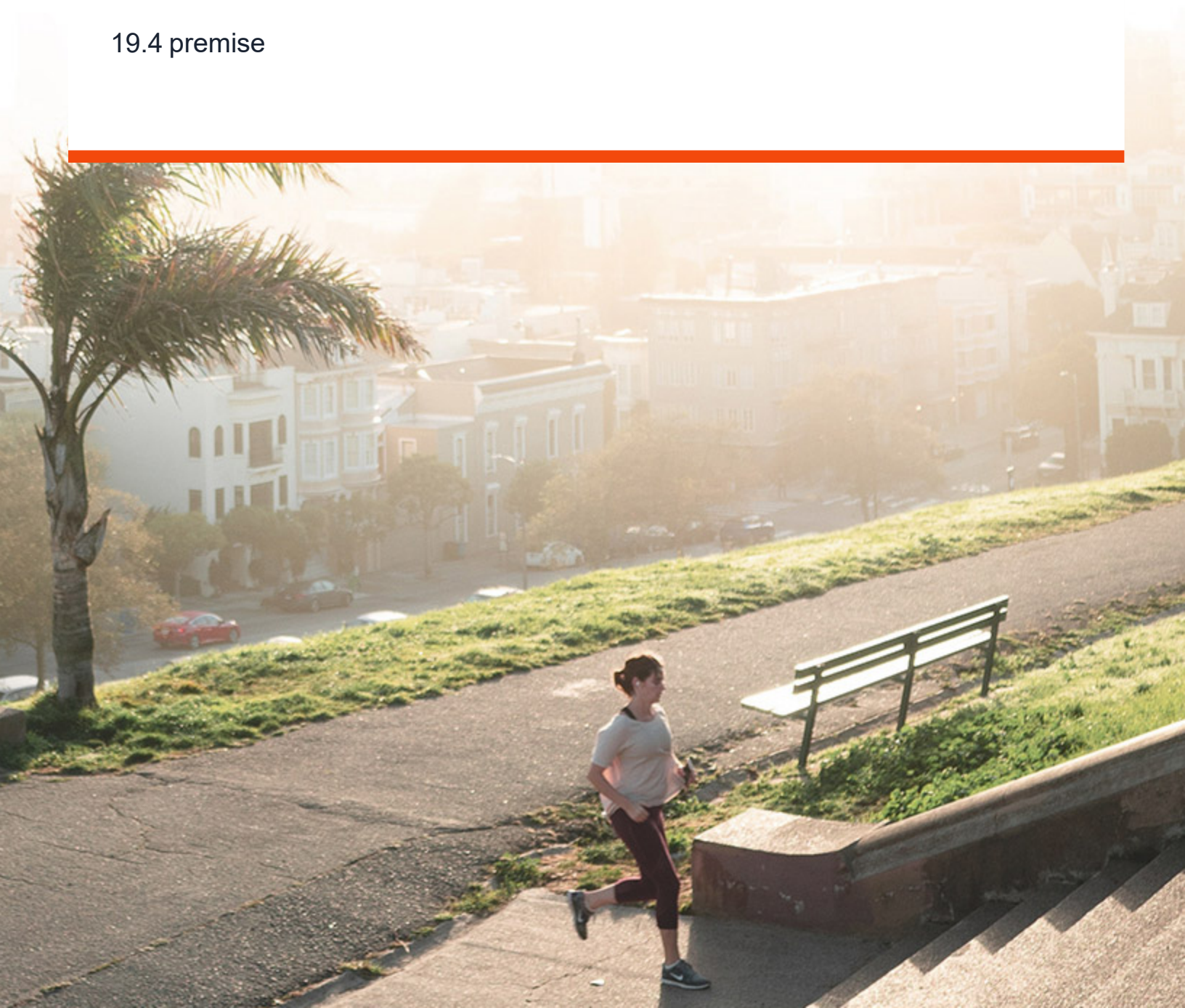

Introduction

These release notes summarize the latest modifications to Community Development applications available for general distribution with the 19.4 release for premise installations.

Important notices

Contractors State License Board (CSLB)—State of California

CSLB updated its security and is now blocking the encryption ciphers bundled with Microsoft Windows Server 2012 and earlier. The CSLB website now requires the more secure encryption ciphers used by Windows Server 2016.

Script updates

Before upgrading to 19.4 from 17.x or earlier, request assistance from the Community Development support team to review your script files for compatibility to ensure proper functionality after the upgrade. The support team will request assistance from the CentralSquare development team to complete this task. This task is a prerequisite for upgrading to 19.4 from 17.x or earlier.

Important: If you are upgrading from or earlier, your custom scripts should be reviewed to determine if they are affected by the payment transaction enhancement.

Upgrade requirements

Upgrade requirements for specific software products are:

- Community Development 19.4: corresponding 19.4 upgrades to Web Utilities & Maintenance (WUM) and all other licensed products.
- IIS: running .NET framework 4.6.2. The web.config file for each of your Community Development websites must have the targetFramework key set to 4.6.2.
- Bluebeam Revu users: IIS configured with TLS 1.2.

Recent Microsoft Windows security updates recommend that users disable TLS 1.0 and 1.1. If you require using HTTPS to access Community Development applications, disable TLS 1.0 and 1.1, and SSL 2.0 and 3.0. Community Development supports these changes in release 18.1 and later.

Mobile Inspection and Mobile Code (iTRAKiT)

Before you upgrade Mobile Inspection and Mobile Code, CentralSquare recommends that you contact the Community Development support team to resolve any questions you may have.

What's new

More ADA compliance enhancements for eTRAKiT public websites

CentralSquare has taken additional steps toward making eTRAKiT public websites compliant with Web Content Accessibility Guidelines (WCAG) 2.1 Level A and AA criteria.

Changes for this release include:

- Modified the **Checkout Summary** page so that assistive technologies can read the **BACK TO SHOPPING CART**, **PAY NOW**, **PAY BY CREDIT CARD**, and **PAY WITH ECHECK** buttons.
- In Agency Center, modified calendar buttons on the **Issued Permits Report** page to be read as buttons rather than links by assistive technologies.

Note: Changes you make through the eTRAKiT custom theme editor or the cascading style sheet (CSS) might impact the accessibility of your sites. To maintain compliance, ensure your changes adhere to the WCAG.

Resolved items

Community Development

- Corrected the contact search to use your selection from the results list when the search results include multiple contacts with the same name. Previously, the first listed contact was always used, regardless of your selection. (Case 01748923, SR 893832)
- Resolved an issue that occurred when you reduced a bond that had a bond-specific contact. (Case 01558996, SR 583672)
- Corrected receipts for bonds to show activity for bond reduction and release. (Case 01588962, Case 01632907, SR 628365)
- Resolved an issue that prevented search results from appearing in the **Payment** dialog box when you search for records to pay. (Case 01783808, SR 881227)
- Corrected the **Paid By** field so that names with an ampersand (&) are stored correctly. (Case 01846663, SR 933847)
- Resolved issues that caused Community Development to stop responding when you worked with fees on a record. (Case 01856408, Case 01861038, Case 01869954, Case 01884443, SR 940787)

Web Utilities & Maintenance (WUM)

- On the **User Names** page, modified the **T9 UserId** field to accept \r and \n as part of the user ID. (Case 01842057, Case 01844942, Case 01857866, Case 01872900, SR 902818)

eTRAKiT

- Made the following changes related to payments (Case 01821225, SR 921596):
 - On the **Fees** tab (record details page), corrected the **Amount** column to calculate amounts properly when the account has a credit.
 - On the **Fees** tab (record details page), corrected the **Paid Date** column to show the fee amount as a link for fees that are unpaid.
 - On the **Shopping Cart** page, changed the **Amount Due** column to show credits as a negative amount (for example, -100.00).
 - On the **Payment Summary** page, corrected the total amount paid calculation to subtract credits.

IVR (Interactive Voice Response)

- Corrected Interactive Voice Response (IVR) inspection scheduling to announce the correct number of inspections available to be scheduled. (Case 01855621, Case 01877391, SR 962839)

Database changes

The 19.4 release does not include database changes.

Supported browsers

Community Development release 19.4 supports Google Chrome, Microsoft Edge based on Chromium, and Internet Explorer 11.

Supported operating systems and database servers

A typical premise installation includes:

- Database server
- Application server
- Web server

These servers must run Windows Server 2012 R2 or later with one of the following SQL Server versions:

- SQL Server 2019
- SQL Server 2017
- SQL Server 2016

Important: The state of California's Contractors State License Board (CSLB) requires Windows Server 2016 or later for security reasons.
