These release notes summarize the latest modifications to TRAKiT.Net available for general distribution with the TRAKiT.Net 2021.08.25.1 release.

Important notices

Upgrade requirements

Upgrade requirements for specific software products are as follows:

- TRAKiT.Net requires .NET framework 4.0
- CentralSquare Mobiles and eTRAKiT users require IIS with .NET framework 4.6.1

Installing updates

To install updates, run the following installation programs:

1. Run TrakitRuntime.exe. This program installs updates that support changes to third-party systems.
2. Run TRAKiT_Server_Update.exe. This program installs the TRAKiT.Net release changes.

The installation also requires downloading the Microsoft OLE DB Driver for SQL Server to your database server and, in your web.config file for all .NET applications, changing the SQL Provider from SQLOLEDB to MSOLEDBSQL. The CentralSquare Installation team makes these updates.

Map support

Esri discontinued support for MapObjects integration for Esri maps. You must use the TRAKiT.Net Silverlight integration for displaying maps. If you currently use MapObjects, contact the CentralSquare support team to request assistance in migrating to Silverlight for displaying maps. TRAKiT.Net and Silverlight are quality-tested using .NET framework 4.0.

Resolved items

TRAKiT.Net

- Corrected Permitting so that users with the `OVERRIDE_FIN_EXP_LOCK` privilege can modify permits that are locked by the finalized date or expiration date. (Case 01550953, SR 545313)
- In LandTRAK, corrected the add record process to use the record type you select in the **Adding Record** dialog box for the new record instead of the record type of the LandTRAK record you were viewing when you started the add process. (Case 01290421, Case 01609829, SR 591457)
- Corrected inspection scheduling for inspectors with inspection caps to set the scheduled date to an available time for the inspector when you use the **Next Available (Insp Cap)** option. Previously, the inspection was always scheduled for the next day, even if the inspector had a full schedule (met caps) or was not available. (Case 01563844, SR 551855)
- Resolved an issue that prevented you from processing fee payments (locked fees) when you changed the sort order in the **Financial Information** pane. (Case 01572862, SR 555965)
- Resolved an issue that caused TRAKiT.Net to close unexpectedly when the **Inspections** pane **Time** column was blank and you pressed **Enter** in that column. (Case 00505854, SR 282709)
- On the main menu, expanded the available space for the agency name to allow for long names with descriptions. (Case 01415839, Case 00855284, SR 314029)

WUM.Net

- Restored the missing delete function (✕) in **Module Configuration > CRM > Status List**. (Case 01696302, SR 626472)

eTRAKiT.Net

- Resolved an error that occurred when citizens tried to apply for a license. The error prevented citizens from completing the application. (Case 01404205, SR 475485)
- Modified eTRAKiT to use the value defined in the PayMethod preference instead of always assigning **CREDIT** as the payment method for eTRAKiT payments. (SR 629624)
- Corrected the Attachments feature for LandTRAK records so that attachments you add are saved only to the geotype record you are working with. Previously, the attachment saved to all geotype records with the same site APN as the record you were working with. (Case 01318318, SR 436563)
